Manure Management Requirements

All farming operations that land apply manure or agricultural process wastewater, whether they generate the manure or import it from another operation, **must** have a written Manure Management Plan. All farming operations that include an Animal Concentration Area (ACA) or pasture **must** have a written Manure Management Plan.

Manure Management Plans can be prepared by the farmer. Manure Management Plans do not have to be submitted for approval but must be kept on the farm and made available upon request.

Ag Erosion & Sedimentation Requirements

PA's Chapter 102 regulations (relates to erosion and sediment control and stormwater management) have existed since 1972. All farms are required to develop and **implement** a written plan to reduce erosion on their crop fields and Animal Heavy Use Areas. All farms need a plan, no matter how small or large. These plans do not have to be submitted for approval but must be kept on the farm and made available upon request.

Please contact your local County Conservation District for more details and specific requirements related to your farming operation.
